



ROAD RULES REMINDER

Mackillop Catholic College ensures that all legal requirements, by law, are met in regards to road markings, speed limits and signage. By entering the College grounds, you accept the responsibility of following and obeying the road rules set down by the College and Police.

Mackillop Catholic College is a very busy place. Many cars, service vehicles, delivery vehicles, buses and bikes enter and leave the College at any given time. Mackillop is a K-12 College and we share our campus with the St Mary of the Cross MacKillop Parish, and as such we have people attending masses on most days and onsite we have OOSHC, which operates before and after school.

Can we use this as a timely REMINDER to all who use the College grounds to be aware, that once you have your child/children safely in your car that there are still other students walking around trying to get home safely.

- All pedestrian crossings must be clear of any traffic at all times. This includes parking or stopping.
- To use a handicap parking space, you must have a valid sticker.
- The small Parish carpark located at the Church entrance is for Parishioners only
- Students walking to and from school must use allocated footpaths and not shortcuts through private bushland
- Mobile phones are a distraction and illegal to use without hands-free while operating a vehicle at any time.
- Students who drive to school must park in the overflow carpark in a safe and orderly manner
- Pay attention to speed limits. You should not exceed 40km/hr during school zone times and travel less than this in shared zones.
- The college grounds is a shared zone and pedestrians must be given right of way during times of congestion
- Kiss and Drop zones are clearly marked and designated for temporary parking only
- Visitors of the college must not use the Warnervale GP Superclinic carpark. Cars who do use this carpark and are not customers of the clinic risk being towed.

It is the responsibility of all who come onto the College site to put the safety of our children first, by not adhering to road rules and not obeying signage puts everyone at risk, especially young students (we are a kindergarten to year 12 College) who have not or are developing awareness of their road behaviours.
