Pending changes to roads in and around the College

Dear Parents & Carers,

The College has been advised that there will be some necessary upgrades and changes to the roads at the top end of the College and Parish. A new residential area will be opened by Allam Homes in the near future. This will mean that some roadworks will be necessary around our College/Parish community.

Work on this subdivision will commence in late May and the upgrade to roads has been pencilled in to start in July. The main areas, which will affect us, will be at the top end of the campus above the Church with our access to the Primary staff parking area and the Primary Kiss and Drop zone.


It will become apparent in the near future that this new subdivision is happening with the amount of machinery, noise and dust in this area. Teachers will prepare our students for this impact here at the College and your conversation with them would also be helpful.

The College and Parish are most grateful to the Allam Homes group and Johnson Civil Engineers who are very mindful of the impact of these developments on the daily operation of the College and Parish. These upgrades and changes to the roads above the College and Church have been programmed to be completed in two stages over two school holiday periods – July and October school holidays.


To understand how these changes will affect us and to explain the future direction of vehicle traffic, a Primary Parent Information Meeting will be held in the College Theatre on Wednesday 19 June. There will be two identical sessions, one at 2.00pm and the other at 6.00pm. These meetings will provide the opportunity for us to advise and discuss with parents how a temporary Primary Kiss and Drop zone may need to operate and what the new process will be for the safe operation of traffic to and from the College.

I thank you in anticipation for your cooperation with these changes to the local roads.
