

MCC Bus Behaviour Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct appears on the School Student Transport Scheme application form and sets out acceptable standards of behaviour for students travelling on buses. Students are expected to follow these simple rules for the safety of themselves and others travelling on buses. Disobeying these rules may lead to the withdrawal of travel passes for subsidized travel and may even lead to prosecution action.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS ON BUSES

To ensure their safety and the comfort of other passengers students will:

- Tap their Opal card each day on each journey
- Behave safely at all times. Only attract the attention of the driver in the case of an emergency.
- Respect the needs and comfort of other passengers and to offer their seats to paying customers.
- Behave appropriately at all times (eg No use of offensive language, fighting, spitting, placing feet or bags on seats or throwing things in or from the bus).
- Protect bus property and report any vandalism
- Only use the travel pass for its intended purpose and maintain possession of the travel pass at all times.
- Follow the drivers instructions about safety on the bus (eg instructions of where to sit)
- Adhere to the law that bans smoking on buses
- Only eat or drink (other than water) on the bus with the written permission of the bus operator
- Keep arms, legs and other parts of their bodies inside the bus at all times.
