NAPLAN

NAPLAN 2025 tests are scheduled between:

Wednesday 12 March to Monday 24 March

Term 1, Weeks 6-8

The test window for NAPLAN Online allows schools flexibility in scheduling.

At MacKillop all online Naplan tests are completed on the student's iPad/laptop. Students must ensure that they have the correct Lockdown Browser installed, their device is fully charged and operable and that they have wired headphones. Students will be informed early in Term 1 of the timetable for NAPLAN tests and the current Lockdown Browser.

NAPLAN Online tests will be taken in a specific order, this increases the security of the writing prompt and is required for some test linkages. For instance, students must complete the Reading test before accessing the Conventions of Language test, so that the results of the reading test can be used to determine the level of difficulty of the conventions of language test items (tailored test design).

The tests will be taken in the following order:

- 1. Writing
- 2. Reading
- 3. Conventions of Language (spelling, grammar and punctuation)
- 4. Numeracy.

Online tailored testing

During the test, students are presented with sets of questions based on their performance. Many of these questions are of mid-range complexity for each year level, but some are of higher or lower complexity. Students who experience difficulty early in the test are given some questions of lower complexity, more suited to their performance. These students are less likely to become discouraged as they progress through the tests. High-achieving students are given questions that they find more challenging.

Students who complete a more complex pathway are more likely to achieve a higher score (and a higher band placement). Students who answer the same number of questions correctly, but follow a less complex pathway, will achieve a lower score.
